

Rahui

Take note on October 19, 2019 a rahui was placed on Tamahere and Rukuhia lands also known as Mangakotukutuku, Tireke, Mangawhero, Te Maire and Pukerimu lands belonging to Ngati Maniapoto (unlawfully taken under an unlawful raupatu confiscation in the 1860s by NZ Company Government for military purposes) for which Her Majesty the Queen has apologised for. The rahui prohibits Amberfield Developments and agents, Peacocks subdivision, the Southern links project of New Zealand Transport Authority and the Hamilton City Council from any further development of their planned 10,000 home housing estate development on our historic, ancestral, and tapu customary lands. The Rahui is in place until further notice or until such times as the aforementioned parties have consulted and or obtained consent from the Sovereign Nga Hapu o Ngati Maniapoto.
